## **NEW TO SHOWING?**

- Look through the schedule and see what you would like to enter
- Fill in the form on page and return by closing date
- On the morning of the show between 8am and 10.30am bring your exhibit and speak to the show organiser who will give you your allocated entry numbers
- Find the corresponding entry number space in the tent
- Place your exhibit within the space allocated
- Put your card face down beneath your exhibit
- No exhibits must be removed before 5pm on the day of the show
- Do not interfere with the other exhibits ask the show steward for help. Only stewards are allowed to move exhibits and exhibitors cards.
- Prize money may be collected from the marquee during the afternoon.

## **TIPS FOR SHOWING IN THE HORTICULTURAL TENT**

- Fruit and Vegetable condition is important
- Tomatoes should be shown with the green stalk (calyx) intact.
- Currant should be shown in bunches as grown
- Gooseberries, raspberries and other soft fruit should be shown with stalk on
- Carrots and Cabbages should have stalks cut to 3 inches approx.
- Flowers should be attractively staged and vases not overcrowded
- Damaged flowers or broken leaves should be removed
- Preserves should be made within the last 12 months and date must be displayed
- Jars and lids of preserves should not display brand names
- Jars should be well filled, cleaned and polished
